# Government/Industry User Pays

In developing an effective work program consideration needs to be given to the challenging question of who should pay

The rule of thumb applied is that **government** needs data and information to support such activities as:

- The national accounts
- International Treaty obligations (Montreal Protocol)
- Regional Forest Agreement processes

While industry's information needs range from

- Micro operational information
- To higher level market information to support longer term strategic thinking and investment
- To socio economic and environmental data which supports the industry social licence



## Main areas of focus

In developing the previous commercial arrangements with ABARES the focus has been on key areas where government and industry have overlapping interests.

- 1. Wood Products Statistics and Modelling
- 2. Resource Availability and Wood Flows
- 3. Processing Capability

The current work program uses a similar structure

Contractual arrangement provides stability for both parties

- Continuity of data and updating of periodic reports
- Continuity of government capacity allocated to our industry.
